PASTOR'S CORNER

'After eight days Jesus came and stood among them.' — John 20:26

The Lord is risen, Alleluia! Blessed be God who in His infinite love and mercy raised Jesus from the dead. The glorious resurrection of Christ gives us joy, peace and hope; it also gives meaning to our earthly existence.

THE PEACE OF CHRIST

All through the fifty days of Easter, we will hear the resurrection narratives from the Gospels. Today, we hear one of the most fascinating post-resurrection appearances of Jesus to the disciples in today's gospel. Heart-broken and distraught, the apostles locked themselves up in a room for fear of the Jewish authorities. The risen Jesus appeared to them and greeted them: "Peace be with you ... receive the Holy Spirit!". Our Lord gives the Apostles a special Gift of the Holy Spirit today to become His ministers of peace, reconciliation, and communion.

SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION

When Jesus says "Peace be with you" twice in this passage, He is showing us that forgiveness is not a one shot deal — or else Baptism would be enough. We're always in need of His mercy because we continue to battle with our sins. When we examine our lives, we always see moments where we could have done more and better, and Confession gives us the peace and grace to keep trying to do more and better. Frequent confession is not only a source of grace but also an opportunity to take stock of how you're doing spiritually.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Today is observed as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the Jubilee Year 2000, St. John Paul II established this new feast to re-emphasize the tremendous gift of Divine Mercy that the Lord wants to pour out on each and every one of us. We experience this unfathomable mercy of God in a special way in the confessional. Jesus Himself gives us this incredible promise through St. Faustina:

"When you approach the confessional, know this, that I myself am waiting there for you. I am only hidden by the priest for I myself act in your soul. Here the misery of the soul meets the God of mercy. Every time you go to confession, immerse yourself entirely in My mercy with great trust, so that I may pour the bounty of My peace upon your soul."

Please join us **Sunday afternoon from 2 — 4 pm** as we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. May we respond with a generous heart and may our lives be filled with God's mercy.



Divine Mercy Promises

1."The souls that say this chaplet will be embraced by My mercy during their lifetime and especially at the hour of their death." [745]

2."When hardened sinners say it, I will fill their souls with peace, and the hour of their death will be a happy one."[1541]

3."Write that when they say this chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as the just Judge but as the merciful Savior. "[1541]

4."Whoever will recite it will receive great mercy at the hour of death." [687]

5. "Priests will recommend it to sinners as their last hope of salvation. Even if there were a sinner most hardened, if he were to recite this chaplet only once, ne were to recite this chaplet only once, he would receive grace from My infinite mercy. I desire that the whole world know My infinite mercy. I desire to grant unimaginable graces to those souls who trust in My mercy." [687]

6."To priests who proclaim and extol My mercy, I will give wondrous power; I will anoint their words and touch the hearts of those to whom they will speak." [1521]

7."At three o'clock, implore My mercy, especially for sinners; and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. abanaonnen at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into My mortal sorrow. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of me in virtue of My Passion." [1320]

8."Souls who spread the honour of My mercy I shield through their entire life as a tender mother her infant, and at

the hour of death I will not be a Judge for them, but the Merciful Savior." [1075]

9."I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I also promise victory over [its] enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death. I Myself will defend it as My own glory. [48]..."The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous....These two rays issued forth from the very depths of My tender ways issued forth from the very depths of My tender mercy when My agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross. These rays shield souls from the wrath of My Father." [299] "I promise that the soul

from the wrath of My Father." [299]

10."I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature: "Jesus, I trust in You." [327]

11."By means of this image I shall grant many graces to souls. It is to be a reminded of the demands of My mercy, because even the strongest faith is of no avail without works." [742]

12."I desire that the Feast of Mercy...be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter...The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of punishment." [699] sins

13."Through the chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for is compatible with My will." [1731]







